

Doodarshan Transmitter Section at Kondapalli and Doodarshan Studio at Vijayawada and for Ten more at the All India Radio Transmitter located in Nambur and All India Radio station at Vijayawada.

Three of the 1st year Students were trained in Incap (an ISO 9001"2001 certified company) at Nidamanuru for one week between 26th October and 1st November 2007. Industrial Linkage Program for the final year students was held at the Steel Plant, Visakhapatnam for one week i.e. 17th to 22nd December on PLC's (Programmable Logic Controllers). Fifteen students participated accompanied by Sri R. Rajesh. Fifteen of the third year students went for TV Training Programme for a period of one month from Dec 5th, 2007 at Raj Electronics and Sairam Electronics

Field Trips. On 20th September, 2007 50 students from final and second year Electronics accompanied by 2 members of the teaching staff visited the Srisailam Left Power House and Srisailam Dam. The final year Electronics students visited at Dooradarshan Kendra and All India Radio stations in Vijayawada from 6th to 8th November 2007. Fifty of the Second year students. Visited Satish Dhawan Space Center SHAR at Sriharo Kota on 21st November. They also visited Nippo Batteries at Tada on the same day. Later on they enjoyed the sights of the Birds Sanctuary at Nelapattu.

Competitions. On 30th November, Four DEP students (15, 24, 27, & 29) got First Prize in intercollegiate Science Exhibition held at Sri Durga Malleswara Siddhartha Mahila Kalasala for their working model of TELE REMOTE CONTROL. Similarly another four more working models were displayed namely Land rover robot, PC Timer, appliances control using remote and automatic wash basin by sixteen final year students.

The Loyola Electronics Department conducted a State Level Quiz Program and Paper Presentation on 4th January. Thirteen teams took part in the quiz event and eight teams presented papers. Electronics Students our department (DEP-01, DEC-18, & NEC-07) won the First Prize in quiz.

Science and Arts Exhibition 1st and 2nd Feb, 2008. All the three year students of Electronics about 120 students, Exhibited 30 working models of their group projects during college Science Exhibition. The TELE REMOTE CONTROL got the *Overall first prize*. The Rocket Launching model was judged as the best among the departmental exhibits. Our Department also secured *first place* for the best models presentations in the college mega exhibition event.

Department magazine (L.E.D Magazine) for this current academic year i.e. 2007-2008 published in March 2008. This contains the departmental activities, articles, recent science developments, cartoons, achievements of the students etc.

From 7th to 15th November the Electronics Department conducted an Inter Departmental Cricket Tournament (L.E.D CRICKET CUP) for the 12th successive year. Electronics Department won the title. Nine Departmental Associations participated

Innovations and best practices initiated / adopted by the department. The innovations and best practices include Industrial training – linkage, Industrial Visits / Educational tours, Preparing working models and displaying in science exhibition, Conducting guest lectures, Teaching through power point presentation, submission of assignments through e mails, Electronics quiz, seminars, etc., Electronics is taught to non-electronics students, Introduction of optional papers and practical's, Final year experiments are also simulated with PC, Printing departmental magazine every year, Conducting Electronics quiz every year for other college students, Displaying current science news and placement advertisements in the departmental notice board, About 10 classes of Bridge course in Electronics subject for 1st years in the beginning of every academic year, Remedial classes for slow learners, Giving printed handouts to the students

Participation of the department in the extension activities of the college. Our department has Prepared Quiz buzzer system to other departments, Curtain raiser using remote for the inauguration of a new block, Podium indicators, TV servicing and Computer Hardware consultancy to all the ALC staff and students at a nominal price, Water tank level indicator circuits to be distributed at a low cost. The Students always participate in cultural activities, sports & games of the college competitions, quiz programs, debate, group discussions science exhibitions, etc.




