**ANDHRA LOYOLA COLLEGE IS A JESUIT COLLEGE IN VIJAYAWADA,
THE SECOND BIGGEST CITY IN ANDHRA PRADESH.**



The Jesuit Fathers founded Andhra Loyola College on 9th December 1953 on an almost 100 Acres Campus. It is the fruit of almost ten years of relentless efforts for a Jesuit College of Bishop Ignatius Mummadi of Guntur at the suggestion of Sir Cattamanchi Ramalinga Reddy, the founder and then Vice Chancellor of Andhra University, towards the end of October 1943, as he could not establish Andhra University in the intended Vijayawada area since the required land in this fertile region could not be acquired at that time within the stipulated time. The local leaders too formed themselves as Vijayawada Loyola College Sahaya Sangham to help the Jesuit Pioneers of the College. The first academic session of the College began on 22 July 1954.

It started functioning as an Autonomous College from the Academic Year 1988-1989. The UGC awarded it the status of a "College with Potential for Excellence" in September 2004 in the first phase itself along with 46 other Colleges at all India level. The Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India, selected it under the Star College Scheme in February 2016; and the Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India, selected it under Fund for Improvement of Science & Technology (FIST) in January 2018 as the one and only College in Telugu States. It was selected under Component - 8 for "Enhancing Quality and Excellence in select Autonomous Colleges under Rashtriya Uchchathar Siksha Abhiyan (RUSA) in June 2018 by the MHRD, Govt. of India. It is the only College that has been getting ranked among the top 150 Colleges from both the Telugu States since the commencement of the National Institute of Ranking Framework (NIRF) Rankings in 2017 to rank more than 43,000 Colleges at the National Level. The Sports Authority of India sanctioned it the prestigious Khelo India Centre in August 2020 as the one and only College in Telugu States.

INSTITUTIONAL CREDENTIALS OF ALC

- ❖ Was awarded Autonomous Status by University Grants Commission (UGC) and has been an Autonomous College since the Academic Year 1988-1989.
- ❖ Only College in both Telugu States, AP and Telangana with below 100 ranks, awarded by Government of India under National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), consistently from 2017 till 2022. All India 24th Rank for Colleges (2017); 56th Rank (2018); 45th Rank (2019); 36th Rank (2020); 34th Rank (2021) and 94th Rank (2022).
- ❖ Accredited by NAAC in May 2002 at the Four-Star Level in I Cycle
- ❖ UGC awarded the status of a “College with Potential for Excellence” as one among the first 47 Colleges in the First Phase itself at the all-India level with a grant of Rs.100 Lakhs.
- ❖ Accredited by NAAC in II Cycle in September 2008 at A Grade with a CGPA of 3.65
- ❖ Accredited by NAAC in March 2017 at A+ Grade with a CGPA of 3.66 in III Cycle, the highest CGPA in AP and Telangana so far.

Revised Choice Based Credit Curricular Framework in Single Major of Government of Andhra Pradesh, in consonance with National Education Policy 2020

Salient Features :

- ❖ The Government of Andhra Pradesh has introduced Single Major Curriculum for all BA/B.Sc/B.Com/BBA/BCA/BMS Degree Programs all across the State of Andhra Pradesh from the academic year 2023 - 2024.
- ❖ Previously a student could get admitted to UG Program with three Majors, for eg., B.Sc - Botany, Zoology and Chemistry or B.Sc - Maths, Physics and Computer Science or B.A - History, Economics and Political Science. From the A.Y. 2023-2024 a student has to get admission into a Single Major like, B.A. in History or B.Sc in Mathematics or B.Sc in Computer Science.
- ❖ Along with a Single Major, a student shall also choose a Minor in any of the subjects offered by the College or acquire the required credits for the minor through online courses.
- ❖ The student is eligible to pursue Postgraduation both in the chosen Major and Minor as well.
- ❖ There is no change in the already existing Single Major Programmes like B.Com/BBA/BCA, etc. However, Minor courses are also added to these Programs.
- ❖ To make the student more employable Skill Enhancement Courses are made part of the Curriculum.
- ❖ All UG Programs are 4-Year Honours Programs with an Exit Option after 1st or 2nd or 3rd year of study.
- ❖ If a student exits after completing 1st year of study, he/she will be awarded a Certificate in the respective discipline.
- ❖ If a student exits after completing 2nd year of study, he/she will be awarded a Diploma in the respective discipline.
- ❖ If a student exits after completing 3- years, he/she will be awarded a Bachelor Degree.
- ❖ If a student completes 4 years of study, he/she will be awarded an Honours Degree.





Andhra Loyola College Genesis

Andhra Loyola College is a Jesuit College in Vijayawada, the second biggest city in Andhra Pradesh and a vital part of its Capital Region. Andhra Loyola College is the realization of the long cherished dreams of the Telugu people, in general, and the Telugu Catholics, in particular, for a Jesuit College as the first Telugu Catholics owe their Catholic Faith to the Jesuit Missionaries of Carnatic Mission of the early 18th Century.

The Madras Presidency of the British India consisted of Tamil, Telugu, Kannada and Malayalam speaking areas. However, over the years the Telugu people asserted their identity to have their neglected needs met in their own land and got Andhra University established in 1926 with Sir C R Reddy as its founding Vice Chancellor. Subsequently, the Telugu people started agitating for a separate State for themselves during the British era itself. The genesis of the College dates back to this time.

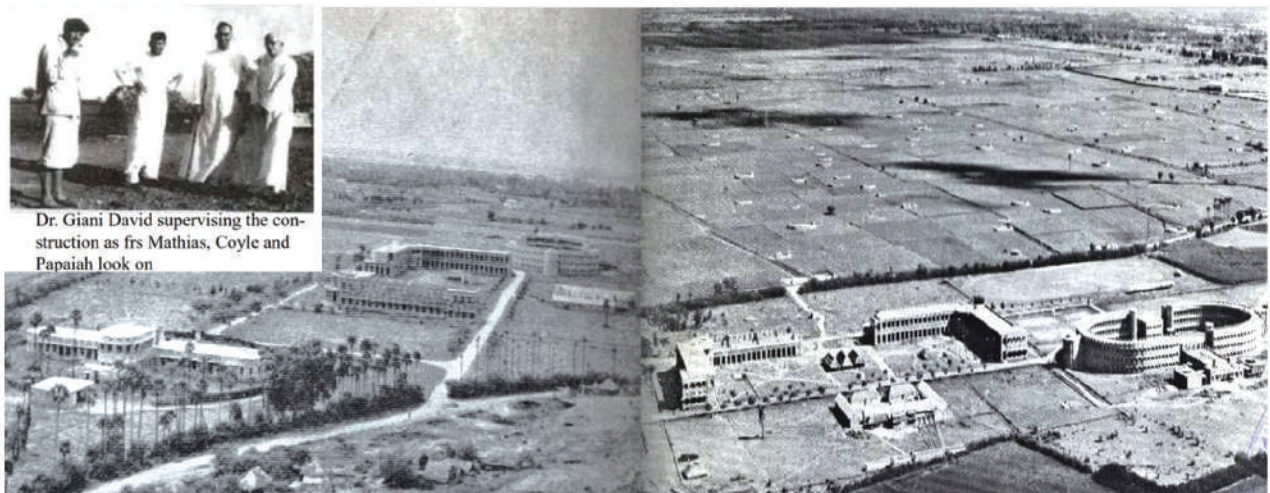
In 1943 when Sir C.R.Reddy felicitating Bishop Ignatius Mummadi after his Episcopal Consecration as the new and second Bishop of Guntur, suggested to him to strive for the establishment of a Jesuit College in Vijayawada area, like Loyola College, Madras (Chennai), as if to make amends for his decision to shift the establishment of Andhra University from the originally intended Vijayawada (which he called Blazewada for its hot summers) to Visakhapatnam, since a single piece of the required vast area of land for a University could not be acquired in the fertile Vijayawada area within the stipulated time.

Sir C.R.Reddy made this suggestion because until then the Telugu Students, in general, had been going to the Jesuit Colleges in the Tamil speaking area of the Madras State for quality education.

Bishop Ignatius Mummadi since then started his relentless efforts to plead with the local Jesuit Superiors repeatedly for the same, but to no avail. Hence, he made it a point to meet the very Rev.Fr.John Baptist Janssens, the then Superior General of the Jesuits in Rome, during his "Ad Limina" visit in 1948 and pleaded with him convincingly for starting a Jesuit College in Andhra area of the then Madras State in Independent India and the Jesuit Superiors finally agreed to consider the sincere request of the Bishop in course of time.

Rev.Fr.K. Francis Devaiah,SJ, a Telugu Jesuit, who was then the Headmaster of St.Mary's High Secondary School, Dindigul, Tamil Nadu,was tasked in April 1952 to select a suitable site for a Jesuit College in Vijayawada area.

Fr. Devaiah reached Guntur on 1st August 1952 and met Bishop Ignatius. Both of them and many local leaders applied themselves to the task of acquiring sufficient and suitable land for the needs of a Jesuit College.

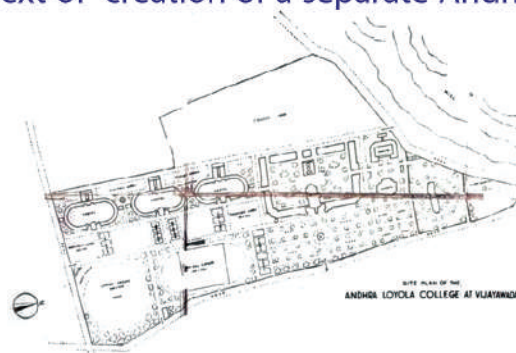
There were many requests and delegations from the people of Bappla, Vetapalam, Nambur, Mukthyla, Seetanagaram, Gannavaram, Vijayawada etc., to start the College in their respective places with offers of required land and money.

After considering various proposals for the College site, Fr. Pinto, the then Jesuit Vice Provincial of Tamil Nadu, favored setting up the College in Vijayawada, and communicated the same to Fr. Devaiah on 2nd January 1953.Accordingly, the process for acquiring the required 100 acres of land in Vijayawada began immediately with the help of Sri.Katragadda Raghu Ramaiah garu, who worked shoulder to shoulder with the Jesuit pioneers, as the Secretary of the Vijayawada Loyola College Sahaya Sangham .

The Loyola College Society, Guntur – Vijayawada, was registered in Guntur on 30th June 1953 and the purchased lands were registered in its name. Sri C.M. Trivedi, the First Governor of Andhra State, (which was newly formed on 1st October 1953, after the self-sacrifice of Amarajeevi Potti Sriramulu),laid the Foundation stone for the College on 9th December 1953 at 4.00 pm. At the suggestion of Sri Katragadda Raghurammaya, the then Jesuit Provincial Superior (and subsequently the second Principal of Andhra Loyola College) Rev.Fr.D.Gordon, SJ, agreed to name the College as Andhra Loyola College, in the jubilant context of creation of a separate Andhra State for the Telugu people of Coastal and Rayalaseema Regions.

The building work began in January 1954 under the supervision of the Italian Missionary Architect Brother Giani David. The first Academic Session of the College began on 22nd July 1954, after two postponements due to heavy monsoon rains.

Andhra Loyola College was admitted by the Director of Public Instruction, Government of Andhra, for Grant in Aid on 18th November 1955. (Gleaned from the first issue of the College Magazine published in March 1956)
