Retirements:

A veteran of our teaching staff, Dr.N.V.Ramana Murthy, Reader in Mathematics, retired from his service during this academic year after putting in 29 years of distinguished service.

Our faculty members are abundantly resourceful and rise up to the occasion to contribute their might for the around development of the College. In a befitting acknowledgement of our faculty's committed contribution, I gladly announce that our College achieved the following distinguished Academic Recognitions since the last College Day:

Institutional Recognition:

1. **NIRF Rank:** The College was awarded the All India 45th Rank for Colleges in April 2019 by the National Institutional Ranking Framework, Ministry of Human Resources Development, Govt. of India.
2. A Certificate of Appreciation was awarded to our College for its significant contribution in "One Student One Tree" initiative at All India Council for Technical Education, on 3rd December 2019.

Infrastructural Development:

An amount of Rs. 2.5 Crores was released to our College during this academic year under the Scheme of Rashtriya Utchathar Siksha Abhiyan (RUSA) of MHRD, Govt. of India. The grant has been utilized for the following developmental activities for the benefit of our student community.

1. **Strengthening of our College Computer Lab** with an addition of 100 more Computers at a cost of Rs. 56,11,475/-;
2. **Establishment of one Digital Class Room and two Virtual Class Rooms** at a cost of Rs. 48,28,074/-;
3. **Establishing a new Mass Communication Lab** at a cost of Rs.28,81,586/-
4. **Procuring Learning Management System (LMS) Software** at a cost of Rs. 32,00,000/- and
5. **Construction of new Class Rooms** for Degree Courses has been undertaken at a cost Rs.90 lakhs.

E-Learning @ ALC VisCom Studios:

Sound Studios with audio work station Presonus 24.4.2 with 24 channel digital console was established with quality microphones such as dynamic, hand-held condensers, and lapel are part of the facilities.

Online Video Production Unit was established too as part of RUSA funds. The online video production studios have a Data Video Switcher with three Panasonic P2HD digital video cameras. The studio also has a teleprompter that would be used to train students in newscasting and also for teaching. The studios boast of professional lights like babies, JEET LED panels, cool lights, spot lights, professional cutter stands with cutters, backdrops, and a green mat.

These new additions make Andhra Loyola College VisComm studios as one of the best in Andhra Pradesh where media programs are run. The purpose of the studios is to enable e-content and also produce online video production and professional audio production.

The new studio was inaugurated by Most Rev. Thelagathoti Joseph Raja Rao, Bishop of Vijayawada, on 31st July 2019.

I hereby place on record all our sincere gratitude and whole-hearted appreciation to Mr.G.M.Srirangam, whose hard work and strenuous efforts as the Coordinator, RUSA & NIRF, made these possible.

E-learning and Digital Content Delivery System: In order to augment e-learning and digital content delivery system on the campus, the Degree Wing Class Rooms have been equipped with 25 LCD projectors together with 31 Speakers and 17 Laptops and the P.G. Section has been provided with 15 LCD projectors, 13 Laptops and 19 Speakers at a total cost of Rs.18,40,000/-. This amount has been contributed by the College Management.

I hereby place on record our sincere thanks and appreciation to Dr.G.Sahaya Baskaran, H.o.D. Physics, for his supervisory role in the installation of LCD Projectors and for imparting training to the Class Monitors in handling the Laptops and the devices.

Profile of the College:

Staff Profile and New Appointments:

Presently the College has a total Faculty Strength of 236 and a Non-Teaching Staff strength of 122 including the newly recruited 48 new Teaching Staff Members and 20 administrative staff in different Departments.

Students' Strength:

The total number of the students has been growing in our College every year in the recent past. In the current academic year, the College has a student strength of 6146, the highest ever in our College history, representing 24 out of the total 29 states in our country. Of this, 1350 are in the Intermediate Wing, 4400 in the Degree Wing and 396 in the Postgraduate Wing.

Examination Results: Here is an overall picture of the examination results of the previous academic year with respect to the Intermediate, Degree and Postgraduate sections.

Our Intermediate, Degree and PG students scored an overall 92, 97 and 96 pass percentages respectively for the last academic year.

Extension Activities undertaken by Postgraduate Section:

Department of MCA

On the occasion of its Silver Jubilee Celebrations, the Department of MCA organized a Cleanliness Drive on 27th July 2019. As part of the drive, the students of the Department cleaned the PG Garden and Botanical Garden. The Department also organized a Plantation Programme and planted more than 100 saplings around the PG Block on 29th July 2019.

Department of MBA

The Department of MBA organized a Two Day “Sramadaanam” Programme on the College Campus on 5th and 6th August 2019. The II Year MBA students planted 65 saplings on the premises of “ALCAA” English Medium School with an objective of reducing Global Warming.

Students from the Department of MBA collected plastic from 11th September to 2nd October 2019 as a part of AICTE Programme and submitted the collected Plastic to the Sub Collector Mr.Chakrapani.

The Department of MBA organised a three-day Sramadaanam Programme from 2nd to 4th December 2019 under which the II Year MBA students cleaned the premises of “ALCAA” English Medium School.

The Department of MBA organised a one day Yoga Programme on 20th December 2019 for II MBA Students as a part of AICTE's Fit India Programme.

PG Department of Physics

Students of the PG Department of Physics led by staff members conducted a One Day "Sramadaanam" programme on 3rd August 2019 to keep the College Campus clean. They also planted a good number of saplings of different species around MCA Lab.

Distribution of Stationary

Second year students of the PG Department of Physics distributed stationary items to the students of ALCAA School on the occasion of Children's Day on 14th November 2019.

PG Department of Chemistry:

Staff and students of the PG Dept. of Chemistry participated in **Development of Tulasi vanam in the P.G block** and in cleaning the garden of P.G Block under **Swatchbharat** Programme on 1st August 2019.

PG Department of Botany:

The Staff and Students of PG Dept. of Botany undertook Plantation Programme along with the School children of Delhi Public School on the College Campus on 31st July 2019.

Student Welfare Schemes:

Subsidized Lunch Scheme: Our Student Welfare Scheme viz. Subsidized Lunch Scheme for the needy Day Scholars and Earn while You Learn programme for Hostel Students continue to be implemented. The benefit of Subsidized Lunch Scheme has been availed by 150 needy students this year. The Management spends an amount of Rs.7,00,000/- on this every year.

Management Freeships and Scholarships: 300 students, including sportsmen and women, got benefitted through the Management Freeships and Scholarships during this academic year to the tune of Rs.20,00,000/- so far.

Equal Opportunities Cell (EOC): This programme is a UGC-sponsored initiative. It aims at providing equal opportunities to students hailing from disadvantaged background. Mr.PVS Sairam is the Coordinator. The topics were self-confidence, motivation, communication skills, career guidance and leadership. This program was conducted from September to December. The students belonging to economically backward families were selected for special training in life skills.

College Dispensary: Established on the Campus from 1st August 2014 with a qualified doctor and an auxiliary nurse to provide medical care to the students and staff, the

Dispensary continues to provide medical services and Generic Medicines to the students and staff, free of cost, on all Working Days.

Higher Education for Persons with Special Needs (HEPSN) – a UGC initiative for the benefit of differently-abled students, under implementation at our College, implements initiatives to provide a supportive environment for the academic growth of physically and visually challenged students by organizing sensitization and motivational programmes, training in computer-aided learning, providing scribes' services during examinations, and connecting the NGOs / Governmental agencies with the visually challenged students, for obtaining necessary support.

Our College has a total number of 52 differently-abled students - 20 visually challenged and 32 orthopedically challenged - pursuing different courses in the current academic year. Dr.G. Sahaya Baskaran, Dept. of Physics, is the Coordinator, for this HEPSN programme. The support to these students is provided through NGOs like Help the Blind Foundation-Hong Kong, Enable India-Bangalore, and government agencies such as Department of Disabled Welfare and Senior Citizens, Govt. of A.P. and AP State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC).

The following activities have been undertaken under the leadership of Dr.G.Sahaya Baskaran, Dept. of Physics, the HEPSN Coordinator.

1. Workshop on Computer Skills for Visually Challenged Students

A two-months long workshop on Computer Skills was conducted with special focus on basics of computer applications like MS office as well as advanced tools like HTML for the students with visual impairments by our HEPSN Unit in collaboration with Enable India, Bengaluru, from 10-07-2019 to 10-09-2019. Sri. M.A. Kumar Raja, Deputy Director, Dept. of Differently Abled & Welfare of Senior Citizens, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh, inaugurated the Workshop on 10-07-2019. Ms. Madhavi, herself a visually challenged trainer from Enable India, was the Resource Person. All the officials of the College were present at the inaugural of the workshop.

2. Distribution of Scholarships to the Visually Challenged Students: Help the Blind Foundation, a Hong Kong based Charitable organization continued its financial support through scholarships this year too. The organization provided scholarships to 67 visually challenged students - of our College as well as of local Colleges - to the tune of Rs. 7,35,000/-. Hostellers were provided with a Scholarship amount of Rs 25,000/- each while Day scholar students were given Rs.10,000/- each. We place on record our

gratitude to the organization for their continued support to our students for the eighth year in succession.

3. Participation in Sports Meet for Persons with Disabilities: Our visually challenged students participated in the Sports Meet for Persons with Disabilities conducted by the Department of Disabled Welfare and Senior Citizens of Krishna District at IGM Stadium, Vijayawada, from 30th November to 3rd December 2019 and won four prizes in Chess and Shot Put in the partially blind and totally blind categories. About 120 volunteers of our HEPSN Unit also extended their support in organizing the event as well as State level and District level Sports Meets.

4. Pratibha Award to Visually Challenged Students:

Two visually challenged students of our Intermediate section namely Peddinti Nitin Sai and Tholeti Sandeep won the state government's Pratibha Award for their academic excellence and securing State First Rank in Intermediate Public Exams-March 2019 in MEC and HEC groups respectively in the Visually Challenged category.

5. Services of Volunteers: Our HEPSN Volunteers' role in running the HEPSN project was remarkable. They rendered multifarious services including 1400 hours of Scribe Assistance during the Examinations, Computer Training for Visually Challenged and supportive role in organising HEPSN activities.

6. Job Mela for Persons with Disabilities:

A job mela for the persons with disabilities was organised on 15-12-2019 on our Campus thorough *Youth4Jobs* in collaboration with HEPSN. About 100 Persons with visual, hearing and orthopedic challenges participated in the Mela. 14 companies including Accenture, Kallam Textiles, Expert solutions, Flipkart, Aegis and First Source have participated. 68 of the persons with disabilities were selected by different companies for positions such as Data Entry Operator, Bar Code Scanner, Office Assistants, Billing Assistants, Accountant, Nursing Assistants and so on.

7. A two-day Bookshare workshop for 40 visually challenged Students of both the ALC and Vijaya Mary Integrated School for the Blind was conducted on 22nd and 23rd January 2020 with Dr. Homiyar, a visually challenged person and the Chief of Bookshare Asia and Africa, and Sri Moses Chowdari from Enable India, Bangalore, as the Resource Persons. Rev Fr.G.M.Victor Emmanuel,SJ, Principal, Rev Fr Dr.M.Sagayaraj, Correspondent, ALC, Rev Sr.Dr.Amala, Vijaya Mary School for the blind, Dr.G.Sahaya

Baskaran, Coordinator of HEPSN, and the staff and students were present at the workshop.

8. **Digital Literacy Centre strengthened:** The Digital Literacy Centre of ALC which imparts computer training to the visually challenged students in collaboration with Enable India Bangalore, has been strengthened this year with the State Bank of India extending its support to it by providing five Laptops, 30 chairs, 10 tables and two Wardrobes at a function held on the Campus on 22nd February 2020. Rev.Fr.G.M.Victor Emmanuel, SJ, Principal, ALC, Sri Mani Palvesan, Chief General Manager, SBI, Amaravathi Circle, Sri Arun Kumar Sahu, Dy. General Manager, SBI, Sri SSV Nagendra Kumar, Regional Manager, SBI, Vijayawada, and Dr.G. Sahaya Baskaran, HEPSN Coordinator along with the volunteers of HEPSN were present on this occasion.

Sports and Games:

Organization: The Department of Physical Education organized Four major Inter-collegiate Tournaments namely Basketball (11th Nov. 2019), Cricket Zonal (14th Oct. 2019), Cricket Central (19th Nov.2019) and Boxing (23rd Nov. 2019) for this academic year on behalf of Krishna University.

Achievements:

1. Our Department of Physical Education won a record of Four Krishna University Inter-Collegiate Championships in Athletics, Basket Ball, Soft Ball, Boxing in Men category and six championships in the second place i.e. Cross Country (Men), Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, Foot Ball, Table Tennis (Women) and Chess (Men) during this academic year.
2. Our Intermediate Volleyball were Runners-Up in the AP CM CUP SGFI under-19 held at Govt. Degree College, Avanigadda.
3. **University Representation:** It is a matter of joy that 43 students of our College, the single largest contingent from any College under Krishna University, were selected to represent Krishna University in the South Zone and All India Inter University Tournaments this year.
4. **National Level Participation:** Twenty four of our students including thirteen students of Intermediate were selected to represent our A.P. State at the National Level events in Handball, Volley Ball, Athletics, Kabaddi, Basketball, Soft Ball, Rifle Shooting, Body Building, Weight-lifting, Judo, Taekwondo and Net Ball.

In addition, our Students won quite a good number of individual prizes all along the Academic Year.

I place on record here our sincere appreciation to Sri J.V.Nagendra Prasad, Physical Education Director, for accompanying our students creditably in this regard.

Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC)

The Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC) commenced its programme on 11th July 2019 with an orientation programme for the students on the importance and benefits of JKC training and a Screening Test for selection of students for training. It was inaugurated by Dr.G.Venkateswara Rao, Coordinator. About 150 students participated in the programme. The training classes commenced 25th July 2019.

The students were trained to equip themselves with Analytical Skills, Technical Skills and Communication Skills. Dr.G.Venkateswara Rao and Dr.T.Srikumar, Dept. of Physics, trained the students in Analytical Skills, Sri T Kamalakar Raju, Dept. of Comp. Science trained the students in Technical Skills and, Sri.N.Ranga Babu, Mrs.T.Sai Mamatha, and Ms.L Subha, Dept. of English, imparted training to the students in Communication Skills.

As part of its activities, JKC organized a Seminar for its students on “Interview Etiquette” on 8th August 2019. Resource Person, Sri.K.Sridhar, Placement Officer, P.B.Siddhartha College, Vijayawada, enlightened the students on the importance of learning interview skills.

The JKC classes ended on 10th January 2020 after successfully training 93 final year students.

- **Conducting Short Term Courses** by Trainers from APSSDC on Aptitude and Soft Skills to enable our final year UG & PG students to face the Campus Recruitment Drives.
