RESOLUTION – 1

I SEMESTER

1. Resolved to make 30% changes in the existing syllabus of General English, paper-1, offered in the I Semester to enhance the Communicative competency and Linguistic skills among the students by making the following changes
 - In UNIT-I the following topics have been included in the topic Paragraph Writing.
 - Structure of Paragraph

 - Strategies for effective Paragraph writing
 - In UNIT-V topics SWOT, Attitude, Emotional Intelligence have been done away with due to overlapping and to enhance the student's learning capacity in tackling the placement tests and competitive exams the following have been introduced in their place.
 - Conversation and Role play
 - Starting a conversation
 - Controlling a conversation
 - Describing one's own strengths and weaknesses in conversation
 - Introducing oneself in formal, informal and social context
 - Telephonic conversations and some model dialogues- Asking for Information, Seeking Permission, Making Suggestions and Giving advice.

A virtual Meeting of the Board of Studies in English in Google Meet was held at 10:00 Amon 15-06-2022. At the opening of the meeting of the BOS, Mr., N Ranga Babu, Chairman of the BOS and the Head OF the Department of English welcomed the members and introduced University Nominee Prof. E. Bhavani and External members Dr.S. Santha Kumari, Dr.M. Raja Ambethkar and Mr. Purnachanra Rao and thereafter, the Items on the agenda were taken for discussion and resolution.

The members of the board have thoroughly examined and analyzed the existing course curricula offered in **Odd Semesters** 1, III and V for all U.G General English and English Literature Courses (B.A, B. Sc & B. Com) and ratified the changes in the updated syllabi from the New Academic Year **2022-2023** by making the following resolutions.

While reviewing the syllabus of first year General English, *A Course in Communication and Soft Skills* Dr M Raja Ambedkar, an external expert felt that the three topics included on paragraph writing seem to be redundant. The HOD, then, explained to him that the inclusion of those three topics has a specific purpose of enabling the students to learn the difference in the layout of different paragraphs and to master the skills of how to apply the knowledge they have acquired by answering the specific tasks assigned by the teacher concerned.

Later there was a discussion on Telephonic Etiquette and the modus operandi of teaching conversational skills to the students. The HOD explained atlength to the Board the topic included on Interpersonal communication and day to day conversations in both formal and informal are indispensable for the students to develop their employability and communication skills to come out with flying colours in placement tests and various competitive examiantions.

After that all the members of the Board unanimously ratified the syllabi offered in General English Courses, Skill Development and Literature Courses. At the end of the meeting the subject experts Dr Santha Kumari, Dr Raja Ambedkar, Prof Poornachandra Rao, an Industry Expert and Dr E Bhavani, University Nominee felt that the courses were well designed and the methodology adopted was quite quite apt and sutiable . They congratulated the Department on having meticulously reviewed and updated the structure and the syllabi of courses.

While ratifying the syllabus of the Certificate Course English for Language and Literature offered in the Semester IV in the Even Semester, Dr Santha Kumari, the external subject expert and Mr D Praveen of the Department of English felt that the syllabus was a bit exhaustive and required to be tailored and reduced as it would be difficult for the lecturer concerned to complete the syllabus in time. Mr N Ranga Babu, the Chairman of the BOS remarked that it was indeed a good suggestion and replied that the issue would be taken up for consideration in the next BOS meet. All the members agreed to this proposal and gave their consent.

There being no other matter, the meeting was concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr B. Raju of the department.












Minutes of the Meeting of the Board of Studies in Electronics
