

At the opening of the meeting of the BOS, Mr., N Ranga Babu, Chairman of the BOS and the Head OF the Department of English welcomed the members and introduced University Nominee Prof. E. Bhavani and External members Dr.S. Santha Kumari, Dr.M. Raja Ambethkar and Mr. Purnachanra Rao and thereafter, the Items on the agenda were taken for discussion and resolution.

The members of the board have thoroughly examined and analyzed the existing course curricula offered in Odd Semesters 1, III and V for all U.G General English and English Literature Courses (B.A, B. Sc & B. Com) and ratified the changes in the updated syllabi from the New Academic Year 2022-2023 by making the following resolutions.

While reviewing the syllabus of first year General English, A Course in Communication and Soft Skills Dr M Raja Ambedkar, an external expert felt that the three topics included on paragraph writing seem to be redundant. 


