ALANA & ALERT

I. ALANA

1. SWATCH BHARAT CLEANLINESS DRIVE:

The Swachh Bharat Cleanliness Drive brought together student volunteers from various schools to the Government Boys Observation Home at Kabela Vijayawada on November 5th, 2021. Eager to make a positive impact, the volunteers of 35 members energetically engaged in cleaning the premises of the facility, reflecting their dedication to community service.

Among the esteemed participants were Mr. Madhusudhan Rao, the Superintendent of the Government Boys Observation Home, and Mr. R. John, the Extension Coordinator of ALC. Their presence underscored the importance of collaborative efforts in fostering cleanliness and hygiene within the community. During the event, Mr. Madhusudan Rao, the Superintendent, took a moment to acknowledge and commend the hard work of the student volunteers. His words of appreciation served as a source of encouragement, reaffirming the significance of collective action in maintaining a clean and healthy environment for all.





2. E-SHRAM REGISTRATION FOR UNORGANIZED LABOUR:

On August 26, 2021, the Ministry of Labour and Employment embarked on a groundbreaking initiative by unveiling the E-Shram portal, aimed at fostering a comprehensive national database for unorganized workers. This pioneering scheme extends eligibility to any individual aged between 16 and 59 for acquiring the E-Shram card.

The cardholders stand to benefit from accident insurance coverage worth Rs 2,00,000 in the event of fatality or permanent disability resulting from an accident. Moreover, a sum of Rs. 1,00,000 is provided for instances of partial disability. Additionally, as part of the ALANA Extension programme, our undergraduate students spearheaded an E-Shram drive from November 1, 2021, to November 19, 2021, successfully registering 250 unorganized laborers under this scheme.

The drive was meticulously orchestrated across Christurajupuram, Gangiredduladibba, and Gundala localities of Vijayawada with the support of 88 Student Volunteers.



3. COVID VACCINATION DRIVE:

Andhra Loyola College under the College Extension Programme organized a Covid Vaccination Drive for the benefit of staff and students on 09.11.2021. Rev. Fr. Dr. S. Melchior, SJ, Treasurer inaugurated the programme and spoke on the importance of vaccines in controlling the viruses. He told one should never forget that prevention is better than cure. A team of Technicians and Health Workers gave Covaxine and Covishield vaccines to more than 350 students and 62 staff members.



4. ALANA – PILLALLA PANDUGA:

Andhra Loyola College, in collaboration with the Yesupadam Charitable Society, organized the Pillala Panduga Programme to entertain and educate street children in the Penamaluru, Poranki, and Krishna Lanka areas of Vijayawada. The DOVE volunteers from Andhra Loyola College coordinated competitions in drawing, elocution, and running races for the children, who participated with great enthusiasm.



Prizes were awarded to the winners to recognize their achievements. The event saw participation from Ms. Zarika, a teacher from Navjeevan Bridge School in Poranki, members and staff of the Yesupadam Charitable Society, Mr. John, the Coordinator of Extension Activities, along with 20 student volunteers. In total, nearly 120 school children enjoyed and engaged in the programme.



5. VISIT TO STREET CHILDREN HOME & GOVT. BOYS OBSERVATION HOME:

As part of the ALANA Extension programme, DOVE (Delegates of Value Education) Student Volunteers embarked on a meaningful visit to SKCV Prema Vihar in Bhavanipuram and the Government Boys Observation Home in Kabela, Vijayawada, on December 21st, 2021. During their visit, the students organized various games and cultural events to engage the children. Additionally, they celebrated a Semi Christmas, spreading cheer by singing Christmas carols and sharing their joy with the children at both SKCV Prema Vihar and the Government Boys Observation Home. This initiative aimed to bring happiness and a sense of community to the children residing in these facilities.





6. SEMI CHRISTMAS WITH STREET CHILDREN & RAG PICKERS:

Christmas is a festival of joy, sharing and caring. To spread the true message of a festival, on behalf of ALANA-MANNA visited slum dwellers at Yandadi Colonies at Krishnalanka, Penamaluru areas in Vijayawada urban on 22nd December 2021 and distributed Christmas cakes and gifts to 125 families of rag pickers. Above 20 student Volunteers and Mr R John, Coordinator, Extension Activities coordinated the entire programme



7. ALANA – MANNA

The Management of Andhra Loyola College initiated a commendable program dedicated to aiding the underprivileged on November 1, 2021. Under the ALANA-MANNA initiative, the dedicated DOVE Volunteers consistently disbursed food parcels to the impoverished individuals dwelling along the streets. Particular emphasis was placed on catering to the needs of the homeless and elderly population.

The designated areas spanning from Benz Circle to Government General Hospital, Ramavarapadu, and BRTS Road were selected for this noble cause. This humanitarian effort persisted until April 30, 2022, serving as a beacon of hope for those in need.





8. DRY RATION DISTRIBUTION FOR PLHA:

As part of the ALANA - MANNA Extension programme, a nutrition support programme was conducted on December 23rd, 2021, specifically for People Living with HIV/AIDS (PLHA), in collaboration with ARHEADS (Adarsha Rural Health and Economic Development Society) in Vijayawada.

The nutrition supplement diet, comprising five different fiber and iron-rich provisions, was distributed to benefit 100 PLHA individuals. Mr. Madhu, the Project Manager at ARHEADS, played a pivotal role in coordinating the entire programme.

Mr. R. John, as the Extension Coordinator, oversaw the logistics, ensuring the smooth execution of the initiative. The active participation of DOVE Student Volunteers further enriched the programme, highlighting the collective effort in supporting and addressing the nutritional needs of individuals living with HIV/AIDS in the community.



II. ALERT

9. PRESERVING LINGUISTIC DIVERSITY: ALC INITIATIVE IN INDIGENOUS LANGUAGE EDUCATION:

In response to the ongoing concerns regarding Tribal School Children, Andhra Loyola College has taken proactive steps to safeguard indigenous languages. Leading this effort, the college initiated a project to produce study materials in Koya and Muriya languages. This endeavor resulted in successful publication of 1000 copies of the 2nd Class Reader in both languages, complete with ISBN certification, on July 31st, 2021. With the invaluable support of local experienced school teachers and Rev. Fr. K. Yesuratnam SJ, Program Coordinator at LITDS Katukapally, hundreds of tribal children now have the opportunity to meaningfully engage with their studies in their mother tongue. This initiative not only preserves linguistic diversity but also upholds the rich cultural heritage inherent in these languages.



10. INTERNATIONAL DAY OF WORLD'S IDIGENOUS PEOPLES:

Student Volunteers of DOVE participated at the International Day of World Indigenous Peoples at Katukapalli, LITDS (Loyola Integrated Tribal Development Society) on 09.08.2021. Sri Sai Naik, Forest Range Officer, Chintur was the chief Guest.

He hoisted the flag at Yedugurallapalli. It was followed by a rally from Yedugurallapalli to LITDS emphasizing the importance of the day. All the tribal people, Adivasi Rights Activists along with the students and staff participated in the rally.

An Early Tribes Museum was inaugurated at the premises of LITDS in memory of the early Adivasi's at Chintur Mandal. Rev. Fr. Yesuratnam, SJ Director, LITDS, Rev. Fr. Paul Amalraja, SJ Superior of Katukapalli Mission, Mr. R. John, Coordinator, Extension Activities coordinated the entire programme under ALERT.



11. ONE DAY SEMINAR ON SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF SCS & STS IN A.P ISSUES CHALLENGES & WAY FORWARD:

The Extension Centre, Andhra Loyola College in collaboration with Department of Social Sciences and Dalit Bahujan Resource Center (DBRC) organized a one-day Seminar on **Socio-Economic Development of SCs and STs in A.P, Issues, Challenges and Way Forward** at the Old Seminar Hall on 25.09.2021. Sri M.D. Imtiaz, IAS, Special Secretary of Minorities Welfare Department, Andhra Pradesh addressed the gathering through Zoom.

Prof. K.Y. Ratnam, Department of Political Science, Osmania University was the key note speaker. Rev. Fr. G. Rayappa, SJ Vice Principal UG, Rev. Fr. B. Bala, SJ, Director, Magic Youth, Members of the Department of Arts and Humanities, NGO representatives and Human Right Activists participated in the informative and intellectual seminar.





12. JUTE HANDICRAFTS UNIT – LOYOLA SHGs INNITIATIVE:

An ambitious idea conceived by rural women, coupled with encouragement from supportive sources and a tremendous amount of hard work, has led Self Help Group members to establish a successful jute product manufacturing unit on December 20th, 2021, at Prajwala JMJ Sadan Home, Hanuman Junction, Krishna District. This home provides refuge for women from diverse backgrounds, including beggars, runaway cases, victims of love breakups, child marriages, abuse, and domestic violence. These women stay in the observation home for periods ranging from one month to five years, depending on their individual circumstances and issues. The main aim of establishing the Jute Bags Handicrafts unit at this location is to empower women facing diverse challenges, as well as those residing

in the rural areas surrounding Hanuman Junction. Additionally, Self Help Group members in Hanuman Junction are providing training to those interested in crafting various jute products such as bags, files, lunch bags, pouches, and cloth bags. Furthermore, another team of SHG members has received training in creating decorative items such as paper flowers and candles. Following the launch of the Jute Handicraft Unit, many women have been able to earn and save money for their family's needs. They have also successfully initiated production and marketing of jute products in Hanuman Junction.



13. AWARENESS PROGRAMME FOR RAG PICKERS ON GOVERNMENT WELFARE SCHEMES & POLICIES:

The Extension Center of Andhra Loyola College organized a one-day Awareness Programme on Government Welfare Schemes and Policies for Rag Pickers in collaboration with DBRC (Dalit Bahujan Resource Center) at the Old Seminar Hall on December 1st, 2021. Sri Samuel Anil Kumar, representing DBRC Guntur, served as the guest speaker, delivering detailed information on various welfare schemes.

He also elucidated the procedures for ragpickers to access such schemes. Reverend Father G. Rayappa, SJ, Vice Principal UG, Reverend Father B. Bala, SJ, Director of Magic Youth, and Mr. R. John, Coordinator of Extension Activities, were present alongside 70 rag pickers from both urban and rural areas of Vijayawada who actively participated in the programme.



14. ALERT – TRIBAL EXPOSURE PROGRAMME:

As part of our College ALERT Extension programme, our first-year degree students, serving as College Student Volunteers, embarked on a meaningful journey of exploration. From the 15th to the 16th of November 2021, they immersed themselves in the community of LITDS Katukapally. Subsequently, on the 17th of November 2021, they continued their mission by visiting the Yesupadam Charitable Society.

During these visits, our students conducted a comprehensive livelihood study among the tribal villages, seeking to gain Tribal Exposure as part of the ALERT Extension programme. Through this hands-on experience, they delved deep into the livelihood conditions of the primitive tribes, studying their cultivation techniques, dietary habits, and health standards. Moreover, they had the opportunity to explore the abundant forest resources, including the unique poodu crops grown on the hills.

Experiencing life without modern amenities firsthand, our students gained invaluable insights into the traditional cultures upheld by these tribal communities. Despite facing challenges such as the lack of proper roads, drinking water, and electricity, the tribes demonstrated remarkable sustainability through their age-old practices.



15. SCIENTIFIC STUDY IN TRIBAL VILLAGES:

Each tribe possesses unique characteristics that contribute to its cultural lifestyle. In an effort to delve deeper into the cultural nuances of a specific tribe, the Department of Service Learning organized a Scientific Study at Kakutapalli, a Tribal Village in Chintur Mandal, from December 10th to December 13th, 2021. Dr. Venu Gopal, a Scientist from LAYA in Narasimpatnam, Visakhapatnam, served as the resource person for this endeavor.

During this initiative, under the ALERT Extension program, student volunteers had the opportunity to learn about the livelihood conditions of the primitive tribes, including their cultivation practices, food habits, and health standards. Moreover, they explored forest resources such as poodu crops on the hills. Mr. R. John, the Coordinator of Extension Activities, along with student volunteers from LITDS Kakutapally, coordinated the entire program, facilitating an enriching experience for all involved.



16. EXHIBITION AND SALE OF HANDICRAFTS AND DECORATIVE ITEMS – LOYOLA SHGs INNITIATIVE:

In the years 2021 and 2022, members of the Loyola Self Help Group organized two exhibitions showcasing their handicrafts and decorative items. The first exhibition took place on November 17, 2021, followed by another in March 2022, specifically on the 10th. These events were held within the premises of our college campus. Through these exhibitions, SHG members not only showcased their products but also honed their communication skills, particularly in sales and marketing.





Furthermore, SHG members extended their outreach by organizing stalls at various locations including schools, colleges, and public places to promote and sell their products. Among the most captivating items featured during these exhibitions were a wide array of jute products such as bags, files, lunch bags, pouches, and cloth bags, alongside decorative items like paper flowers and candles. These exhibitions not only served as platforms for showcasing their craftsmanship but also facilitated rural women in earning and saving money for their families' needs, thus contributing to their empowerment and financial independence.
